Figure:

Heads (sides) promenade it's halfway round you go. Walk in and square through, it's four hands round you go. Go all the way and do a right and left through. Pass through trade by. Touch ¼ then. Scoot back and then scoot back again. Star through and promenade around that big ol' ring God bless the happy trails that led his horse to town. Hey beach cowboy, glad you came around.
